Welcome to the 2020-21 school year! I hope this communication finds you and your loved ones safe and well. The start of this school year brings many new processes for all of us. Some processes are ready to share and some are still in development due to the constantly changing circumstances and new policies brought forth to ensure everyone's safety. This letter is to provide you with important information on the start of the school year.

The first day of school is **Monday, August 17th**.

All BUSD schools will be using 100% distance learning for at least the first 6 weeks of school. The current guideline is that schools cannot reopen until their county is off the watchlist for at least 14 days. Once we have reached that point, BUSD will begin communicating our hybrid learning plan and safety procedures to keep everyone safe. With the ever changing landscape of COVID-19, we will continue to update everyone as we receive more guidance.

Student Nutrition Services

- O Grab and Go Lunches will begin on Monday, August 17th at Vinci Park Elementary.
