## How to Safely Wear and Take Off a Mask

#### **WEAR YOUR FACE MASK CORRECTLY**

- · Wash your hands before putting on your mask
- · Put it over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin
- · Try to fit it snugly against the sides of your face
- · Make sure you can breathe easily
- Do not place a mask on a child younger than 2







### **USE THE MASK TO HELP PROTECT OTHERS**

- Wear a mask to help protect others in case you're infected but don't have symptoms
- Keep the mask on your face the entire time you're in public
- · Don't put the mask around your neck or up on your forehead
- · Don't touch the mask, and, if you do, clean your hands

#### **FOLLOW EVERYDAY HEALTH HABITS**

- · Stay at least 6 feet away from others
- Avoid contact with people who are sick
- Wash your hands often, with soap and water, for at least 20 seconds each time
- · Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available





## TAKE OFF YOUR MASK CAREFULLY, WHEN YOU'RE HOME

- Untie the strings behind your head or stretch the ear loops
- Handle only by the ear loops or ties
- · Fold outside corners together
- · Place covering in the washing machine
- · Wash your hands with soap and water



Personal masks are not surgical masks or N-95 respirators, both of which should be saved for health care workers and other medical first responders.
