We're off to a great start!!! Thank you for sending us (virtually) the very best students ever! We've had a wonderful couple of weeks and have enjoyed seeing your children. Thank you for your cooperation with our multiple student check-ins throughout the day. Our students' education is of paramount concern.

At Vinci Park, we are committed to reflecting the diversity of our world in our classrooms. We feel very fortunate to have so many children and families from different cultures. In the first three weeks of school, we focus on classroom routines, rituals and culture. We have conversations around how we are both different and the same. We use this concept to begin teaching children about tolerance and respect for cultural and ethnic differences. In our quest to reduce all types of violence for children, we want to help children discover that difference is not to be feared and that violence is not inevitable.

We believe we can teach nonviolence and respect for others at every level, even in the smallest daily interactions. <u>Social and Emotional Learning - All</u> <u>About Feelings</u>

Social and emotional learning (SEL) provides a foundation for safe and positive learning, and enhances students' ability to succeed in school, careers and life. Research shows that SEL not only improves achievement by an average of 11 percentile points, but it also increases prosocial behaviors (such as kindness, sharing and empathy), improves student attitudes toward school, and reduces depression and stress among students (Durlak et al., 2011).
