A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL, MS. NUNEZ

We're off to a great start!!! Thank you for sending us the very best students ever! We've had a wonderful couple of weeks and have enjoyed being with your children. Thank you for your cooperation with our student drop-off and pick -up. Our students and staff safety is of paramount concern. Please continue to bring your students to the office if they are late for school. Remember to get out of your car and walk the children across the street using the crosswalks. Never load or unload next to a red or yellow curb. Just as a reminder supervision at school starts at 7:55 AM.

Classes are well underway with a wide variety of learning experiences. Students will meet with their teacher(s) to develop individual goals in reading, writing, and math; monthly progress monitoring will measure growth of student goals. Ideally, a student on grade level in reading should grow a year; if a student is behind in reading, the goal is to grow a year and a half. Growth will occur by practicing reading at school and at home (even during the weekends and holidays). This practice will help our primary goals: improve reading skills, increase knowledge, and develop a love of reading. Parents can model by reading with their students and reading for enjoyment. Our focus is on student achievement: academic, social, and emotional. We encourage you to stay on top of information and assignments from the classroom. Throughout the year, we will continue to focus on student success and work to ensure our students are college and career ready. As a school, we will specifically target improvement in literacy.

We are thrilled to be a part of your child's life this year and pledge to do our very best to help inspire and empower them to lead successful lives. We are here to support the success of your child. In these trying times, we appreciate the support and understanding of the teachers, school, and district. 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A Message from School Nutrition Services

National School Lunch Week is October 11 – 15! Recent research indicates that children get their healthiest meals at school. School meals provide a balance of protein, whole grains, fresh fruit/veggies, and milk.They must also comply with federal nutrition standards that limit fat, calories, and sodium.

Thanks to pandemic waivers, school meals are FREE for all students this school year, so it's a great time to give school lunch a try! Every student is entitled to one free breakfast and one free lunch per school day while attending in-person classes. Breakfast is served daily during your student's Recess period. Lately, there have been severe nationwide disruptions to the food supply chain that are impacting school foodservice programs as well. Fortunately, Student Nutrition Services has been able to keep up with the increased demand for school meals and decreased supply of food.However, planned menu offerings must occasionally change due to weekly delivery shortages of food and supplies.
