A MESSAGE FROM OUR HEALTH CLERK, MISS MICHELLE:

Please pick up any unused medication(s) that your child has in the school office by the end of the last day of school. The school cannot store medication in the office over the summer, and unclaimed medications will be disposed of 1 week after the last day of school.

If your child will continue to need ANY medication(s) during the school day during the next school year, including any over-the-counter medications such as Tylenol, Benadryl, and/or Advil, the Berryessa School Permission Medication Form must be completed and signed by both the health care provider and the parent/guardian.

Medication forms are available in the school office.

NOTE: A SEPARATE MEDICATION AUTHORIZATION FORM IS REQUIRED FOR EACH MEDICATION EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

PICK UP THE ALLERGY PLAN FORM, IF YOUR CHILD WILL REQUIRE MEDICATION AT SCHOOL FOR ANY TYPE OF ALLERGIES.
